2022-2023 Financial Updates:

Bank Account Balance

- Funds allocated to Intervention Tutoring in future years: \$50,883.78
- General Operating Funds: \$42,233.27


The generosity of families and Corporate Sponsorships has allowed us to do so much already this year! Some highlights include:

- Finalized Annual Giving Campaign for total income of \$44,780.42 and total expenses of \$16,977.82.
- \$500 to CPA to complete non-profit IRS filing; \$20 non-profit TN Annual Report fee
- \$605 annual PTO insurance to cover events and liabilities.
- Purchased books on teachers' wishlists from the Book Fair to be used as Titles for Tomorrow gifts. This means classrooms get books the teachers want and 30% of our purchase goes back to the library! (\$1736)
- \$748 for Grounds Beautifications supplies and Brag Tag incentives
- \$875 on new gear for our Safety Patrol hats and umbrellas
- \$102 to purchase cookies for Family Reading Night
- \$8,150 to paint the rest of front hallways, teachers lounge and Mrs. Beckwith's office
- \$11,787 for fall teacher Amazon wishlists
- Received \$1227 from Kroger & Superlo rewards
- Readathon has currently made \$13,350! Another week remains to reach the \$15,000 goal. \$356 spent on Readathon supplies
- Made \$4395 on Spirit Wear in just 3 months with our new vendor; fall sale will be live next week!

As we have said before, due to the Pandemic and the addition of SEA's, our Intervention Tutoring fund has a substantial balance. We are working with our admin team to find extra educational support areas to spend down these excess allocated funds. Some highlights include:

- \$9500 for Accelerated Reader & Star Tests
- \$150 to each math teacher to support the change in curriculum
- \$20,475 spent on device storage for homeroom teachers, as all devices now remain at school
- \$2914 on books for 3rd, 4th, & 5th upcoming book studies
- \$1043 on Orton Gillingham support manuals for K-5 ELA teachers
