Dear Parents,

This is a friendly reminder that the PTO School-Based Decision-Making Council amended the school uniform policy during the 2015-2016 school year. The uniform policy was posted on both the school and PTO website all summer and it is listed in the Parent/Teacher Handbook online.

The uniform policy is as follows:

- Solid red, white or gray shirts or polo style dresses may be worn.
- **Solid navy blue or black shirts or solid navy blue, black or khaki dresses are not part of the Richland School uniform and may not be worn.**
- Pants, knee-length shorts, skirts or jumpers must be navy blue, black, or khaki (Jumpers have a strap with a uniform shirt worn underneath).
- The rule of thumb for Dresses vs. Jumpers is: Solid Polo-style dresses must be the shirt color: red, white, or gray. Jumpers are the pant color (navy blue, khaki, or black) since a shirt or blouse is worn underneath.
- Students may wear Richland spirit-wear (clothing with Richland logos). They may also wear sweaters or light jackets in any of the uniform colors (navy blue, red, khaki, gray, white, or black) over their uniforms while in the building.
- Tights or leggings must be worn under skirts, dresses, or jumpers, and may not be worn as the pants only. They can be any of the uniform colors: red, white, gray, khaki, navy blue, or black.
- Shoes must have a strap around the heel and Crocs are **not** permitted.
- **Boosterthon and former field day shirts, are not allowed to be worn during the school day.**
